COURSE OBJEKTIVES

During this intensive course, the participants will review 60 cases dealing with a variety of benign and malignant breast neoplasms and tumor-like lesions. Several common diagnostic problems including papillary neoplasms, intraductal proliferative lesions, variants of ductal and lobular intraepithelial neoplasias, and carcinomas are included.

On each day, 20 cases will be extensively discussed by an interactive approach. Particular attention will be paid to the diagnostic criteria with systematic analysis of differential diagnoses. Value and limitations of immunohistochemistry as a diagnostic adjunct will be demonstrated. A comprehensive review and update of histopathology with discussion of clinical significance of benign, intraepithelial and malignant lesions of the breast will be provided.
