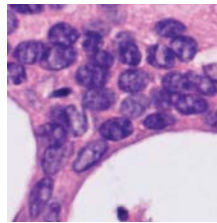
COURSE DESCRIPTION

The course is organized as a theoretical-practical review of relevant aspects of breast pathology.

The course is designed to be very interactive.

The faculty will give lectures, show typical morphologic entities and discuss how to approach specific issues in multiheaded microscopes (two 15 headed microscopes in 2 microscopes with projection screens), dividing the attendants into 4 different groups. The attendants will rotate through all the different settings, so everyone will have similar exposure to the invited faculty, cases and settings.

The course is limited to 90 individuals in order to accommodate everybody at the practical sessions. An option to attend only the lectures is also available with a lower registration fee and limited to 110 individuals plus.
